

Giants Gain League Lead When Poat Blanks Cardinals

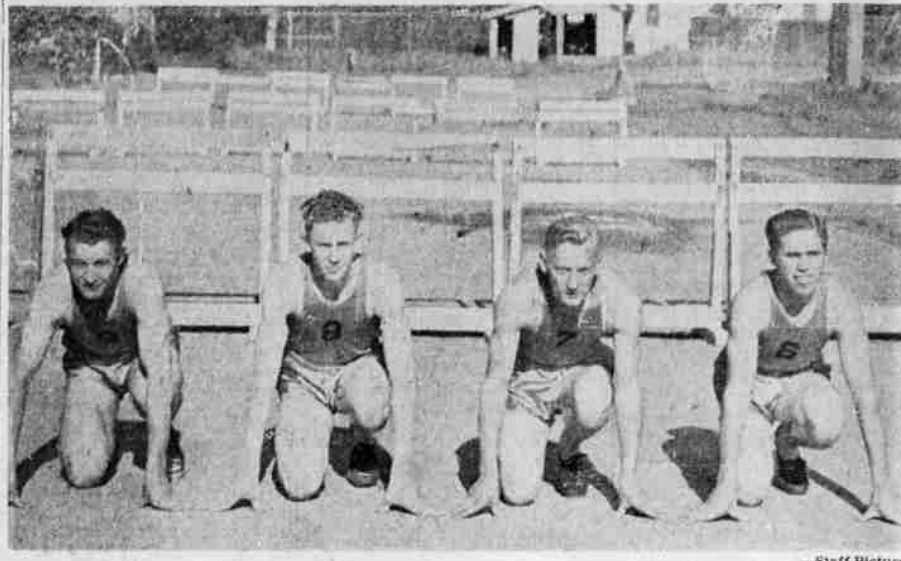

Ray Poat's spring success takes the heat off New York Giant official who booted Bill Voiselle to Boston.

The two-hit shutout that Poat threw against the St. Louis Cardinals yesterday boosted the Giants into the National League lead. Despite Voiselle's four straight victories, the Braves still are in the second division.

Poat, purchased from Baltimore last summer after failing to make the grade with Cleveland, now has won three of four.
