Flood Damage Mounts Death Toll Up to 1

At Elmer City, low Coulee dam, 35 families were evacuated from their homes. Fifty homes in the Okanogan Valley were flooded last night.

In Chelan Coulee, a score of homes and cabins were evacuated. These were on Wenatchee River near Camanche and at Chelan landing at the Columbia. Water swirled seven feet deep through several orchards in the Wenatchee area. Some houses were afloat in lowlands there.

Ellensburg Filled
The rain did runoff-swollen Yakima River up about a foot overnight, topped at the top of dikes on the south edge of Cle Elum today and spread out over hundreds of acres of lowlands in the lower Kittitas Valley west of Ellensburg.

Heavy night rains sent virtually all the creeks in the valley out of their banks, pouring a heavy volume of water through Ellensburg streets and increasing the threat of a major flood. But lower temperatures offered the hope of a reduced flow within 48 hours.

Cle Elum city officials said the Yakima was aping at the top of dikes two feet above the level of its street, the city's main street and would take out the Northern Pacific tracks if the dike broke. Crews were at work halting the dike with rock. Lowers beyond the tracks were flooded.

Meanwhile a second successive night of electric storms erupted in service. Service was interrupted to the main city water was on the Yakima River and city returned to the use of water from flood-swollen Nantum creek for fire protection.
