Roseburg Soldier Plays Lead Role In Comedy in Japan



Pfc. Wayne Wagner, Roseburg, above, is currently playing one of the male leads in the 24th Division Soldier Show, "Dear Ruth," rollicking wartime romance comedy now playing in the Tokyo-Yokohama area according to information received here by his mother, Mrs. Charles F. Wagner, 535 Mill Street. Clippings from an English language paper in Japan state that the show began a three weeks' run in the Stillwell theater July 9. The play was given next at the Ernie Pyle Theater, then travelled to the Bill Chickerling Theater in Yokohama. The play was to show in Yokohama July 20, then at the Fourth Replacement Depot, the Fifth Air Force installations in the Tokyo area and finally ending its tour with a show in Nagoya on July 30. Prior to coming to the Tokyo area, the clipping states, the play, which was a Broadway hit, had a successful tour in the First Corps area, Kyoto, Japan. Directed by Barbara Spencer, a theatrical technician of Portland, Ore., the cast includes Doreen McClean, Jane Clairborne, and Pauline De Crocker, all stage stars in their own right, both in Hollywood and Broadway, and First Sgt. Charles Willeford, and T/S David Tucker. Pfc. Wagner will be sent to the United States about August 1, after which time he will have served two years, and he plans to enroll in his fall at the University of Oregon in Eugene.
