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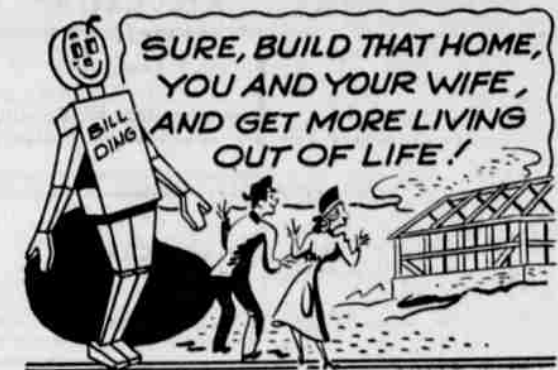

Hearing Set on Suits Filed by Accident Board

August 13 at 10 a.m. in the Circuit Court is the date and time set by Circuit Judge Carl E. Wimberly for hearings on two separate suits brought by the State Industrial Accident Commission. One is against Milo M. Clough-ton, the other against Clifford D. Losey and Clayton D. Losey. Both suits ask for a decree requiring the defendants to post cash deposits or bond securing the months' advance payment under the Workmen's Compensation Act.

Judge Wimberly has entered a judgment by default in favor of W. G. O'Brien against Aaron Reddekopp for \$464 plus costs and disbursements for alleged contract wages due.

An order for dismissal, upon request of the contestants, has been issued by Judge Wimberly in the suit of Eino Hemmilla vs. Fred Forbes and Claude Boswell.

for the Farm Security Administration at that time. He is no longer with the government.

Official On Grill
While Miss Bentley was testifying to the House Committee, Senate investigators were questioning William W. Remington, Commerce Department official.

Miss Bentley told the senators yesterday that Remington was a Communist and gave her secret information on American plane production during the war.

Remington, under oath, told the senators he would have left the government long ago except for a firm conviction in my innocence.

In response to questions from members of the Senate Expenditures Subcommittee, Remington testified:

1: That at a time when the FBI was investigating his association with Miss Bentley he was offered a job with the Atomic Energy Commission.

2: He held a White House job and handled secret data also while under FBI investigation.

3: He resigned a Naval Reserve commission in the spring of last year by request, but did not connect the request with the FBI probe.

It was last spring that he got into his present Commerce Department job which involves presiding over a committee to pass on exports to Russia.

Various Others Named
Miss Bentley spoke of two main "groups" in the government with whom she dealt. She called one the "Silvermaster group" and the other the "Perlo group."

She said the latter group was named after its "ostensible leader" whom she identified as Victor Perlo, formerly employed in the War Production Board.

She named several former government employees as members of the Perlo group. These included: Allen Rosenberg of the Foreign Economic Administration.

Donald Wheeler of the Office of Strategic Services.

Charles Cramer who she said was employed by both Senators Kilgore (D-W.Va.) and Pepper (D-Kan.) on the Senate Subcommittee on Education and Labor.

Edward Fitzgerald of the War Production Board.

Harry Magdoff of the Commerce Department.

She said Cramer told her he was a "long standing member of the Communist party. She added that Rosenberg, Wheeler and Fitzgerald also were Communists.

Asked if White was a Communist, Miss Bentley replied:

"I don't know whether he was a card carrying Communist or not." But she insisted he gave information to Silvermaster.

Another member of the Silvermaster group, she said, was William Taylor, employed by the Treasury. She said Taylor whose position she did not know, was sent abroad and at one time served in Portugal.

Robert E. Stripling, committee counsel, brought out later that "according to our investigation" Cramer actually worked in Senator Pepper's office although on the payroll of the Senate Education Committee.

He said Cramer's real name is Krivitsky. Miss Bentley said she understood that was right.

Miss Bentley told the Senate group yesterday that Remington gave her secret government information during the war and she passed it on to Russian agents.

Remington denies that.

Remington also testified that he served on a White House staff and handled secret and top secret data at the same time he was under investigation by the FBI for "disloyal activities."

The young official said he was a staff member for President Truman's Council of Economic Advisors.

Since last spring, Remington has had a Commerce Department job which involves passing on what goods can be shipped to Russia. He has held other government posts in the past.

Previously, Remington had told the committee that he was associated with Communist sympathizers while attending Columbia

University, New York City.

Remington has denied to reporters that he was ever a Communist party member. Miss Bentley testified she had collected party dues from him.
