SAN ANTONIO, Tex., Aug. 6.—(AP)—Two training planes from Randolph Air Force Base collided in the air north of here today and four fliers were killed. One plane plummeted to the earth in a mass of flames. The collision of the two AT-6 trainers was seven miles south of New Braunfels.

Reported instantly killed were two instructors, an aviation cadet and a student flying officer. Names of the dead were withheld pending notification of next of kin.

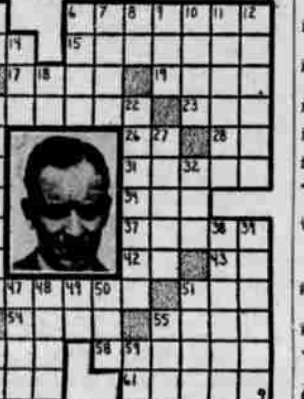
