'Voice of America' Again Jammed in Russian Regions

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13.—(AP) Evidence of deliberate Soviet jamming of "Voice of America" broadcasts to Russia was reported today by State Department officials.

They said that reports reaching Washington from radio monitors in Europe indicate the interference is originating well inside Russia. Several months ago the United States protested to Moscow against the howls and squeals that were being heard in American broadcasts to the Far East. But today's was the first report

of what appears to be Russian jamming of radio waves on the European side of the Soviet Union. Officials here said the government has made no protest about the new situation because of a desire to handle the matter quietly and informally. They expressed hope for an agreement to avert a contest in which the United States and the Soviet Union each would try to interfere with the other's broadcast.

Information about the interference as more like "heckling" than outright jamming — was learned here as it was believed that the State Department has projected a huge expansion of its "Voice of America" operations.

Ten new languages are to be added, including Ukrainian. The Ukrainian broadcasts will be the first beamed to the Soviet Union in any language other than Russian. The Ukraine is one of the most nationalistic of the Soviet states.

The other nine languages in which the department plans to undertake new programs by October 1 are Arabic, Persian, Turkish, Portuguese, Danish, Swedish, Norwegian, Finnish and Dutch. They will raise the total number of languages used by the Voice of America to 32.

Eugene Woman Sues For Larger Share of Estate CHICAGO, Aug. 13 (AP)—A Eugene, Ore., woman today contested disposition of a \$2,000,000 estate left by Chicagoan Mrs. Elaine Horton Witteveen of Eugene, and Ivan Horton, Detroit, said in a Circuit Court suit that they were left only \$1,000 each from the estate of their uncle, Roswell G. Ackley.

They contended other relatives used undue influence to get Ackley to change his original desire to leave his estate to all his heirs. Ackley, a southside real estate dealer for more than 40 years, died at the age of 74 last November. The bulk of his estate went to two nephews, Clark T. Ackley and Glen F. Ackley, both Chicago.
