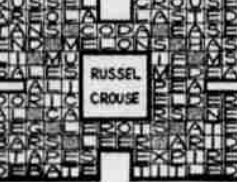

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN THAT the Common Council of the City of Roseburg, Oregon, will hold a public hearing and afford persons particularly interested and the general public an opportunity to be heard in the Council Chambers in the City Hall of said city at 7:30 P. M. on August 18th, 1948, at 7:30 P. M. against the following proposed change:

To change all of that part of the following described area of the said city which is not now within and classified as an Industrial and Warehouse area from a Class 2 Residential District to a Class 4 Warehouse and Industrial District, to-wit:

Bounded on the South by the Northern line of Oak street, on the North and West by the South Umpqua River, on the East by the Western line of Spruce street and on the North by the Southern line of Washington street.

Said change is proposed to be made in accordance with the provisions of and definitions of said Districts set forth in Ordinance No. 1065 in the City of Roseburg, Oregon.
