LOS ANGELES, Aug. 27.—(AP)—It took actress Lynn Merrick, 25, five months to make up her mind definitely, but she has obtained her final divorce decree from Conrad Nagel, 50, stage and screen actor.

She obtained an interlocutory decree March 26, 1947, when she complained that the actor, former matinee idol, had been too long a bachelor between marriages. She was granted her final decree yesterday, five months after she could have had it under California law.

She said he had been a bachelor so long he "made me feel like a guest in the house" and didn't let her do the family shopping or give directives to the servants.

They were married in Fort Lee, N. J., Dec. 21, 1945, more than 10 years after he had been divorced from his former wife, Mrs. Ruth Helms Nagel.
