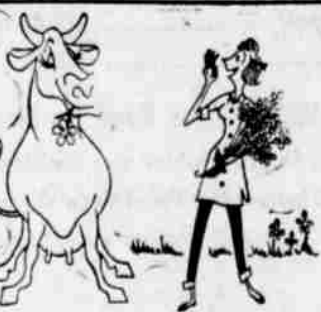

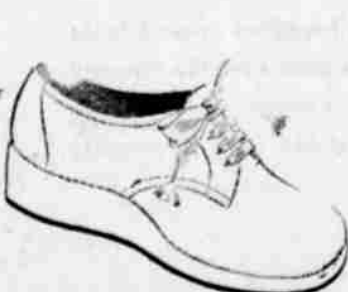

These areas gave the following gasoline supply reports:

Los Angeles—hard hit because its oil storage facilities do not approximate those of other areas. Northern California—estimated by industry spokesmen as good for 10 to 12 days.

Oregon and Washington—no rationing expected for at least two weeks, but Governor Wallgren, of Washington, appointed A. J. Zimmerman of the State Utilities Department as a state coordinator in charge of voluntary allocations of motor fuels.

Nevada—"No Gas" signs appeared on many service stations. Other stations were rationing two to five gallons per customer.

Deadly Volcanic Gases Threaten Lives of 13,000

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ated to nearby Mindanao. Word that all of the Filipinos still on the island were safe as late as 7 p. m. came from volcanologist Arturo Alcaraz, who, 18 hours earlier, broadcast an urgent appeal for ships to take off the inhabitants as the poisonous gases started spewing from the volcano.

There was not even an assurance here that the 20 to 30 inter-island vessels usually in that vicinity had heard the distress message.

Distress Message Sent Alcaraz, who sent the message from Camiguin had used a frequency not usually listened to by these vessels.

Alcaraz said acidic ash, probably containing one of the deadly chlorines, was raining from Hibokhibok volcano, which is in eruption for the tenth day after 77 years of inactivity.

Equally menacing, the mile-high volcano has opened a third crater far down its western slope. This crater, the second formed since the eruption began, is near Catarman, second largest town on the island.

Anxious authorities in Manila, fearing a disaster without precedent in the Philippines, had reason to hope.

tween Salem and Eugene. Fifty-eight wires were cut and 50 crewmen of the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company worked for six hours to make repairs shortly before midnight. Another fire at Salem, breaking out in the smoking rooms, destroyed the Salem Meat Company plant at an estimated \$50,000 loss.

The Lake Quinalt fire was reported covering 100 acres and burning out of control.

The district fire warden at Hoquiam, Wash., said logging operations in that area would be forced to close if there was no break in the weather soon.

Medford's 101-degree temperature yesterday was the top figure, but all of the northwest was warm and some of it was downright sizzling. Salem's 98 degrees was the hottest there since July 20, two years ago. Portland's 94 was the year's hottest.

Roseburg shared Salem's 98; The Dalles had 96. Even the coast was hot—Astoria had an estimated 96 or 97. Newport had an official 83. Brookings, along the southern coast, was an oasis—it had a cool 58.

East of the Cascades, Ontario and Lakeview reported 89, Baker, Burns and Klamath Falls 88 and Pendleton 87.

The weather bureau said temperatures today would range from 92 to 102 in the interior of western Oregon today.

It will be quite a little cooler tomorrow, especially in the northern part of western Oregon. Eastern Oregon will not be as hot as the western area today, but it won't get a change tomorrow—the forecast says 84 to 94 degrees both days.

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agreed to on a four power basis." He pointed out to the Russians that much detail on flights is already being furnished daily through the air safety center and is available to the Soviets there.

Gookin said the tone of the Soviet letter "requesting guarantees" was firmer than any of their previous communications on this subject.

"It looks like they intend a squeeze," he said.

American pilots said there was no unusual air activity reported today in the corridors or over Berlin.

Allied sources voiced open concern that mounting incidents between Communist and anti-Communist Germans might pile up to a point where four-power negotiations now being held on the Berlin stalemate might break down completely.

Youth Killed in Riot Last night's street fighting between Berlin civilians and Russian troops, supported by Soviet zone German police, cost the life of one German youth and injuries to at least 22 other Germans, police reports said.

The clashes occurred near the historic Brandenburger gate, which marks the division of Berlin into east and west, after 200,000 Germans had demonstrated in a nearby square against the Communist drive for power over the city.

Crowds hurled rocks at three Russian soldiers in a jeep and at Russian-controlled police.

Russian military police and their German colleagues fired in

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to the throngs of anti-Communist demonstrators.

British sector police headquarters said Fritz Schuermann, 16, died from gunfire wounds in the stomach while en route to a hospital. They said six other injured civilians, including three with bullet wounds are in British sector hospitals.

The deputy police chief of the Soviet sector said five of his men were injured, one seriously.

The Communist press claimed the demonstration was directed against the Soviet military administration. It carried a veiled hint of Russian reaction, and renewed demands for ousting the elected anti-Communist city government.

The Socialist press claimed the Soviet-controlled police "indiscriminately" arrested about 90 men and women in the Russian zone on their way home from the rally. The papers said those arrested were pushed "and in some cases fired upon" by the Communist controlled police.

The Soviet police later announced they had arrested 27 demonstrators inside the Russian zone. They said all were placed in Soviet sector jails, the Russian-licensed news agency reported.
