Motor Vehicle Registrations In Oregon Increasing

Oregon motor vehicle registrations are continuing their climb to new heights with 572,261 listed to the end of August, a 12 per cent gain over last year, Secretary of State Newby has reported.

At the same time, registration fees have dropped far below 1947 collections, Newby said. He explained the decrease is due to a change in the method of registering trucks and buses. Such vehicles now pay a highway use tax, with license fees greatly reduced.

Buses led all other classifications in percentage increases with a gain of 59 per cent over 1947, the secretary said. Motorcycles and pickup trucks have increased 24 and 23 per cent respectively. The two largest groups, passenger cars and trucks, have each gained 11 per cent. Passenger registrations now total 431,670.

Receipts of the driver's license division are nearly double those

Traffic Accidents, Injuries in Oregon Show Slight Rise

Recently completed tabulations of Oregon's traffic accident record for the first six months of 1948 reveal that accidents and injuries increased nearly three percent over the same period last year, but deaths declined almost 10 percent, Secretary of State Newby has announced.

He added that additional reports of deaths through the month of August improves the fatality decrease to 14 per cent from the figure for last year. Throughout the year, travel has remained approximately 10 per cent higher than 1947, he said.

Greatest decline in any accident classification was in pedestrian deaths. Forty were killed

in contrast with 51 in the same period last year for a decline of 22 per cent. More than half the pedestrian fatalities, 23 out of 40, were under 15 or over 65 years of age, Newby pointed out. He said crossing streets between intersections was the leading factor in bringing death to walkers.

Railroad crossing mishaps led in the fatality increases, with 14 losing their lives as compared with only six last year. This figure was only exceeded the complete grade crossing toll for 1947, the secretary noted.

The proportion of deaths occurring in rural locations was 78 per cent, remaining nearly constant with the 76 per cent for the same period last year and 79 per cent for the final figure for 1947.

Newby emphasized that the lion's share of the death decrease was accomplished in cities and towns, declaring "we can expect no permanent improvement in

YAKIMA—(AP)—A railway locomotive has been "drafted" by the California Packing Corporation.

When essential parts for an additional cannery boiler failed to arrive in time for the prune processing, the cannery called on the Northern Pacific Railway for a locomotive. The plant's normal boiler capacity is being used to operate peach canners.
