

Funeral Services Held at Reedsport For W. D. Simons

Funeral services were held at Reedsport Sunday for Wilfred DeWitt Simons of Gardiner, who died at the Kelzer Hospital in North Bend Thursday, Oct. 7.

He was born in Browton, Minnesota, Sept. 10, 1877, and lived there and in Kansas until he came west and settled at Olympia, Wash., where he attended school.

He was married to Mabelle Waring in 1902, and moved to Aberdeen, Washington, to work in a sawmill. They moved in 1920 to Bordeaux, near Olympia, where he was sawyer in a sawmill until he came to Gardiner to serve as sawyer in 1941. Mrs. Simons moved to Gardiner a year later, and they have made their home there since that time.

Mr. Simons was a past master of Olympia Lodge No. 1, A. F. & M. of Olympia, Washington, and took an active part in Masonic work. The Masonic funeral service was held here by Aurora Lodge No. 59, A. F. & A. M., of Gardiner. The body was shipped to Olympia for interment in the Masonic Cemetery where he had served as a member of the cemetery board for several years.

Survivors include the widow, Mrs. Mabelle Simons of Gardiner; one son George M. Simons, and one daughter, Mrs. Dorothy Husen of Reedsport, five granddaughters; and one sister, Hattie Harshner.

The price to producers for butterfat fell three cents a pound at the same time.

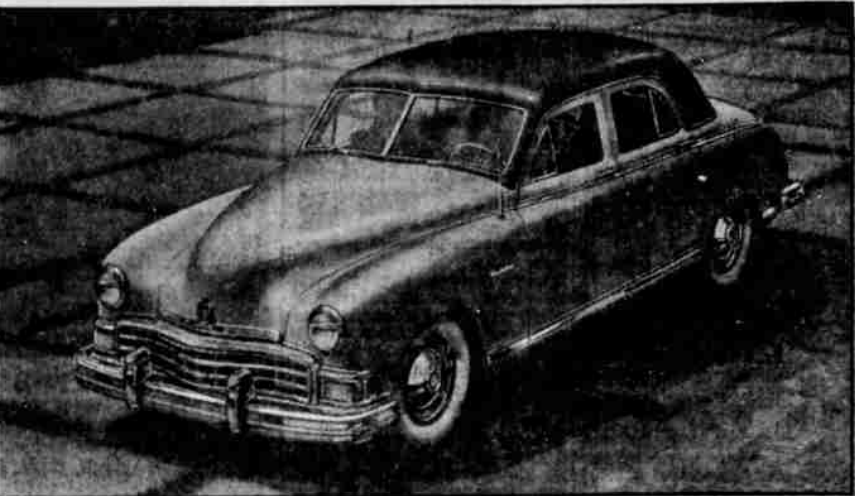
It is the second case in three weeks to be reported from this county. There have been no other cases in the county this year.

Luxury, Economy Combined in '49 Manhattan

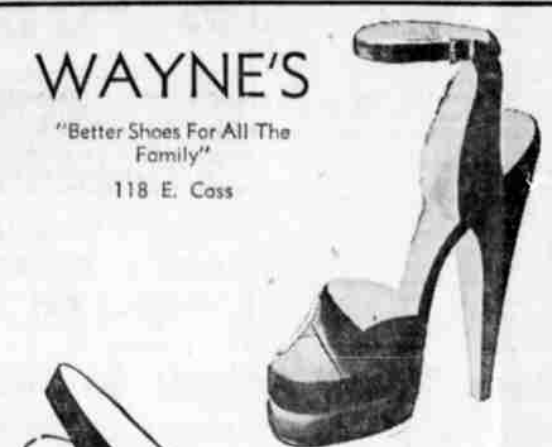
