Communist Labor Head In Havana Shot to Death

HAVANA, Cuba, Oct. 18.—(AP)—A Communist maritime labor leader, shot in front of union headquarters yesterday, died of his wounds today.

Police have detained four suspects in the shooting of the Communist, Aracelio Iglesias, 43. Two other maritime workers were injured in this first outbreak of violence in Cuba since Carlos Socarras became president Oct. 10. The shooting was believed to be the climax of a long tilt between Communist and anti-Communist labor leaders.

WILL CAN OYSTERS
NORTH BEND, Oct. 18.—(AP)—A small seafood canning plant established by George Beckner plans to begin canning of oysters from Coos Bay when harvesting starts in February.

Oyster canning has not been undertaken here since 1945, when the State Sanitary Board forbade sale of fresh oysters from the bay because of pollution. The ban does not affect canning of oysters.

TRAMPS GET BREAK

CLEMSFORD, Eng., Oct. 18.—(AP)—Tramps hereafter will ride the cushions through rolling Essex County—by order of the County Council.

The Council instructed its welfare officers to hire taxis for any tramps stranded at night so the tramps can ride to the nearest council hostel. In the daytime, the tramps will get bus fare.

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Legion Convention To Hear Truman, Warren, Stassen

MIAMI, Fla., Oct. 18.—(AP)—President Truman flew here today for what he described as a "non-political" address to the American Legion.

The former World War I field artillery captain arrived in the announced role of commander-in-chief and chairman of the Missouri delegation to the convention.

A 21-gun salute heralded his landing at Miami International Airport. Planes of the Air Force formed an umbrella overhead.

Republican Vice-Presidential Candidate Earl Warren, is due tomorrow and will address the convention Wednesday. Harold E. Stassen, former governor of Minnesota and a Republican spokesman, also arrives tomorrow and Legion officials said he probably would be a speaker.

Navy Secretary John L. Sullivan arrived yesterday and will make a major address late today. Other cabinet members also are on the program.

While the four-day convention did not open until today, Legionnaires and their families have been pouring into the city for more than a week. They came in 36 special trains, two steamships, scores of planes and thousands of automobiles.

The crowd packed Miami and spilled over into other communities in the greater Miami area. Legionnaires thronged downtown streets, staging harmless pranks, snarling traffic and creating confusion in general.

The Forty and Eight Society, fun-making body of the Legion, opened its parallel convention at Miami Beach with a gigantic parade last night.
