

Vets Ask Funds To Build Homes For Wheelchair Life

Five Oregon veterans have applied for federal funds to help them build homes designed for wheelchair living, Clifford Fields, VA contact representative at the

Roseburg Veterans Hospital, said today. Application forms have been sent out to 20 ex-servicemen whose disabilities may entitle them to special housing grants, Fields said. Forms are available through any VA office for those who may not have received notices.

To be eligible, veterans must have suffered a permanent total paralysis of the legs and lower body, due to disease or injury. Authorized by the 80th congress the grants cover half the cost of building but not more than \$10,000. The homes feature ramps instead of stairways, wide doorways and special bathroom and exercising facilities.

Eligible veterans may obtain plans for such homes from the VA free of charge.

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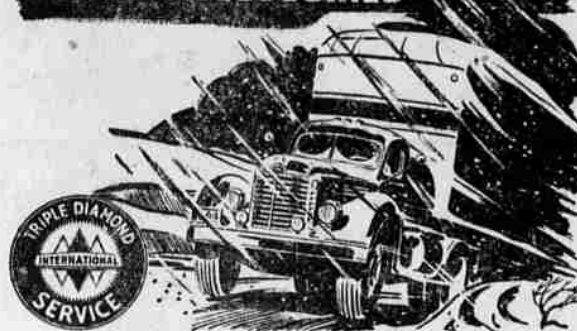

Grand Jury Faces Lengthy Session

The Grand Jury for the Douglas County Circuit convened at 10 o'clock today with a large criminal docket listed for investigation. Since all grand jury proceedings are strictly secret, no information is available as to the cases to receive attention.

District Attorney H. A. Canaday said today that indications are that this will be one of the heaviest grand jury sessions on record.

Some of the cases previously announced as assigned to the Grand Jury from the Justice Court will not come up, as the accused parties will waive investigation and go directly before the circuit judge on the district attorney's information. This will eliminate considerable work of the jurors, but there will still be plenty of cases up for investigation, Canaday stated.

Maurice D. Swank Of Glendale Passes Away

Swiss Oust Rodeo Troupe Because Of Battle at Show

GENEVA, Switzerland, Oct. 26.—(AP)—The Gene police chief said Larry Sunbrock will be expelled from Switzerland this afternoon with his cowboys and cowgirls, accused of engaging in a free-for-all fight with Swiss police Sunday.

Chief Marc Gaudet said the performers will be taken to the French border in police vans and sent on their way.

The troupe was sequestered in the city jail pending the trip. They have been in police custody most of the time since the fracas. The expulsion will take place at the border crossing near Annemasse, France.

Sunbrock was questioned today by authorities who sought his version of the free-for-all which occurred at the Palais Des Expositions.

No charge except that of "gravely abusing the hospitality of our country" has been placed against the 40 American rodeo performers, who were ordered expelled from Switzerland yesterday.

Actor Richard Dix Fights Third Heart Attack

MONROVIA, Calif., Oct. 26.—(AP)—Richard Dix, the veteran film actor, is under special care after suffering a third heart attack within the last 18 months. Dix, 33, one of the silent screen's biggest box office attractions, is recuperating in a sanitarium here. All he needs is sufficient rest, his wife says.

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
