Washington Goes For Truman, But Wallgren Loses

Mounting returns today put Washington's eight electoral votes in the Truman column and apparently headed Arthur B. Langlie back to the Governor's mansion.

The Republican nominee, who lost the Governorship four years ago, slowly increased his lead over Governor Wallgren throughout the night and early morning.

With 1408 of the state's 3457 precincts reported, the vote stood Langlie 151,673; Wallgren 137,812; Russell Fluitt, Progressive Party candidate, had 7,323.

In a highlight contest of the election, State Rep. Herbert Hamblen of Spokane pulled into a clear lead over Victor A. Meyers during the early morning hours in the so-called race for Lieutenant Governor.

President Truman stretched his lead over Governor Dewey, the Republican standard bearer, to more than 20,000 early today.

The state seemed almost certain to add a second Democrat Congressman to its six-member delegation.

Former U. S. Sen. Hugh Mitchell appeared to be scoring a political comeback.

On 559 out of 773 precincts in the first district, he was leading Rep. Homer Jones, the Republican incumbent, 73,197 to 67,057.

Neck and Neck in 3rd District
Another ding-dong congressional battle was being waged in the

third district (southwest Washington).
Rep. Russell Mack, Republican, was holding a lead of less than 200 over former Rep. Charles Savage, the Democrat he defeated last year in the district's special election. That lead was on the basis of less than one-fourth of the slow returns from the district.

Rep. Henry Jackson, the state's lone Democrat Congressman, appeared certain of reelection.

With about one-fourth of the precincts reported, Jackson had a lead of more than 5,000 over Payson Peterson, the nine-time Republican nominee.

In other Congressional races, Republican Congressman Walt Horan, fifth district, and Hal Holmes, fourth, were widening leads that appeared to be decisive over John McKay and Coach John Eulank, respectively.

Rep. Thorp, Tollefson, Tacoma Republican, was reelected by a

wide margin for a second term. He defeated Jack Knudsen, Democrat from King County.

Democrats were sweeping the other state offices, except land commissioner. The lead changed hands repeatedly during the night in that race.

Land commissioner Otto Case, running as a Republican after having been elected previously as a Democrat, took a lead of nearly 9,000 today.
