

Michigan Shoots For 23rd Victory Over Ohio State

NEW YORK, Nov. 20. (AP)—Rampant Michigan, shooting for its 23rd straight victory, and hepped-up Ohio State, itching for an upset, tangled today in the No. 1 game of college football's last crowded Saturday.

The campaign dribbles out a few weeks longer before being smacked by the bowl rush but this is the windup for many of the major events.

Conference championships and important bowl bids hang in the balance at a number of points. Elsewhere knee-deep tradition is the main consideration.

A crowd of 80,000 is expected to gather in Ohio's commodious stadium at Columbus to watch Michigan, the nation's top-ranked team, try to put the finishing touches on its second straight perfect season.

Ohio State, whipped twice but still having an outside chance to land in the Rose Bowl, is reported at razor edge for this one and all primed to fashion the reversal of the year. Realists, however, have installed the power-packed Wolverines 14-point favorites.

Ohio's hopes of landing the Pasadena trip depend on Northwestern stubbing a toe against Illinois today at Evanston. If they can take the Illini, the Wildcats are a cinch to get the bowl nod.

But if Northwestern slips up, both Ohio State and Minnesota, if victorious, would be eligible to argue the point. Minnesota's opposition of the day is furnished by Wisconsin at Madison.

The other piece in the Pasadena jigsaw also has yet to be put in place on the Pacific Coast. Both California and Oregon are contending for the championship with unsoiled league records.

California's unbeaten, untied Bears play Stanford at Berkeley while Oregon, loser only to Michigan, invades Oregon State.

If both the leaders prevail, the Pacific Coast Conference will pick the bowl representative by a vote.

Southern Methodist can save Southwest Conference directors that discomfort by polishing off Baylor at Dallas. Baylor is the last large obstacle between the Mustangs and the Cotton Bowl.
