Dentist Meets Death
In Portland Home Fire

PORTLAND, Nov. 20.—(P)—An elderly dentist burned to death today, just a year after his daughter met violent death. The body of Dr. Francis Scott Weir, about 60, was found in his blazing room early this morn-

ing. The fire, which Battalion Chief Raymond R. Danford attributed to a discarded match or cigarette, apparently started in the sofa. Dr. Weir's daughter, Mrs. A. T. Carter, was killed in an Alaskan plane crash last Thanksgiving Day.

Association Would Call
Tax Commission on Bills

PORTLAND, Nov. 20.—(P)—The Association of Oregon Counties wants to call in the State Tax Commission to prevent any future financial messes like that caused by the recently approved old age pension plan.

A resolution at the annual association convention here yesterday would give the tax commission a voice in such bills. First of all any such plans would have to contain a provision for a tax levy, the resolution said. Then the commission could study, and, if necessary, increase the tax levy so that the measure is properly financed.

Wallace S. Wharton, state tax commissioner, suggested as a further step in straightening out financial snarls that training courses be adopted for assessors and tax collectors.

Reedsport to Get
Wireless Station
Telephone System

Survey for the establishment of a wireless telephone station in Reedsport has been completed by Mr. Peck of the Newport Office of the Central Lincoln Public Utilities District.

At the present time, the PUD has a short-distance radio transmitter at Reedsport. Peck said it is the PUD's intention to establish permanent stations at Waldport, Yachats, Florence, Reedsport, and Lakeside and at least 12 mobile units between these points.

The system will be operated on a frequency that will not interfere with any other radio system, said Peck. There is a possibility the PUD system may be hooked in with Reedsport's police and fire department cars and the State Police network.

If this can be done reasonably, law enforcement in the coastal area will be greatly facilitated, as the State Police system there meets many local disturbances, it is said.

Peck said he would "at once" start to make a survey in the Reedsport area to eliminate local radio interference, which is caused in large part, he said, by leakage of current from antiquated electric power lines along the coast.

A radio antenna, part of the new station at Reedsport, will

be erected on a high hill in the southeast part of the city just within the city limits.
