National Service
Life Insurance
Offered to Vets

National Service Life Insurance is still available to most World War 11 veterans, even though they may not have taken out a policy while in service, Clifford Fields, Veterans Administration contact representative at the Veterans Hospital, Roseburg, stated today.

Any ex-GI who served honorably between October 8, 1940, and September 2, 1945, is eligible to apply to the VA for insurance, Fields said. This can be for new insurance or for reinstatement of a lapsed GI policy. Veterans must pass an insurance physical examination, however, unless they had a policy

Employers Deny Wage
Hike Offer to Strikers

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 24.—(AP)—Employers denied today reports that CIO longshoremen had been offered and refused a 13-cent hourly wage hike. Negotiations in the 83-day west coast maritime strike continued.

Longshoremen demanded a 15-cent boost above the base pay of \$1.67 an hour when they walked out.

In Washington, George Killian, president of the American Steamship Lines, predicted yesterday that longshore phase of the strike would end by the first of next week.

Four other unions are involved in the walkout, but Harry Bridges' longshoremen are considered the key strikers.
