Seal Sale Opens To Fight TB In Coming Year

This week marks the opening of the 42nd annual Christmas seal sale to raise funds for local and state tuberculosis control programs for the coming year.

In Oregon some 3,000 organizations are taking part in the 1948 campaign. Ninety-five per cent of the proceeds remain in the state to be used for health education, mass x-rays and care of present tuberculosis patients. The remaining 5 per cent goes to the national association for medical research.

Already more than 5,000 letters containing the new seals have gone into the mails to Roseburg and Douglas County residents, according to Mrs. W. F. Amiot, executive secretary of the Douglas County Tuberculosis and Health Association. Youngster on Seal
