Government Holds Up Sale of Utah Hospital

DENVER, Dec. 7.—(P)—Regional Director John A. Skeen of the War Assets Administration said yesterday all action concerning disposal of the 10-million-dollar Bushnell General Hospital at Brigham City, Utah, has been suspended.

At the request of the Department of the Interior, Skeen said, the WAA is withholding action on two bids filed to take over the hospital.

It was reported here that the Interior Department is interested in Bushnell as the possible site of an Indian school and will send a representative there this week to look over the property.

The two bids were filed by the Hill Military Academy of Portland, Ore., and the Rev. Father Lawrence of Chicago. The latter told WAA he proposed to set up an establishment similar to Boys Town, Neb.

Head of Western Union Telegraph Co. Passes

PARIS, Dec. 7.—(P)—Joseph L. Egan, president of Western Union Telegraph Co., died of a heart attack yesterday at Monte Carlo, company officials here announced.

Egan, 62, was elected president of Western Union in November 1945, after serving as vice president in charge of public relations since 1939.
