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Oregon's Volcanic Ash May be Used in Glazing

BEND, Ore., Dec. 10.—(P)—Possibility of using Oregon volcanic ash in ceramic glazing will be studied by the Oregon State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

The Chamber of Commerce here has been advised by F. W. Libbey, department director, that a research project will be set up.
