Public Invited To Red Cross Program At Junior High

The general public is invited to a general Red Cross meeting scheduled for Tuesday, Jan. 4, at 7:30 p. m. in the Junior High School auditorium, announced Russell Stephens, executive secretary.

Included on the program will be talks on Junior Red Cross and volunteer service work. A display will be made of colored slides, showing the school children's international art project work sent overseas.

Sgt. William Burke of the Roseburg police force will give a brief talk on first aid and the need for highway first aid stations. Members of the current class in advanced first aid, taught by Sgt. Burke, will give a demonstration of first aid techniques. The members will also receive first aid certificates for having completed the course.

Representatives from the Veterans Hospital and from the Gray Ladies will be present to speak.

In connection with the first aid demonstration, a short movie will be shown on first aid and accident prevention. The title is "Disaster Is Your Companion."

Other entertainment will be provided, including musical selections. The program will be under the direction of Allen Clute, chairman of the Red Cross executive board.

Ex-Oregonian Chosen President of RCA

ASTORIA, Dec. 30.—(AP)—A former Oregonian who never went to college and began his career as an elevator operator will become president of the Radio Corporation of America Jan. 1.

He is Frank M. Folsom, brother of Mrs. Edward Stupfel of Astoria. Folsom succeeds David Sarnoff, who will retain his post as chairman of the board of RCA.

Folsom began as a stock clerk and elevator operator at the Lipman-Wolfe Department Store in Portland.

But by 1932, Folsom had become vice president in charge of merchandising for Montgomery Ward and Company. Later he became executive vice president of Goldblatt Brothers in New York and Chicago.

He and his sister were reared at McMinnville.

He never went to college but holds honorary degrees and is on the governing boards of several colleges and universities.

Guard at Lincoln's Tomb For 27 Years to Retire

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Dec. 31.—(AP)—Herbert Wells Fay, the kindly elderly gentleman who has guarded Abraham Lincoln's final resting place since 1921, is going to retire.

Fay, almost a legendary figure at Lincoln's tomb, will leave his job January 1 as custodian of the 17-foot granite monument in Springfield's Oak Ridge cemetery. He will be 90 years old Feb. 28.

He will be succeeded by his son, Earl Owen Fay, 63, appointed custodian by Governor Dwight H. Green. The Fays live in Lincoln Lodge, next to the tomb.
