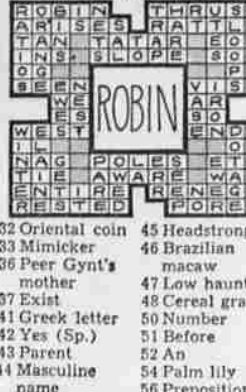

IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES FOR THE DISTRICT OF OREGON, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, v. UMPQUA BRAND BUTTER, PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 27th day of December 1948, 60 cases, each containing 36 1/2 lb. prints, individually wrapped, were arrested and taken into the possession of and now are in the possession of the United States Marshal for the District of Oregon, pursuant to a warrant and process duly issued by the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Oregon, in a suit for condemnation and forfeiture entitled, U. S. v. 60 Cases, more or less, each containing 36 1/2 lb. prints, individually wrapped (print wrapper) "UMPQUA BRAND BUTTER manufactured by Umpqua Dairy Products Co., Roseburg, Ore. etc." brought under the provisions of Section 334, Title 21, U.S.C.A., wherein it is sought to have the above-described article of food condemned and forfeited for the following reasons: That on or about the 27th day of November, 1948, the said article of food was shipped in interstate commerce from Emmett, Idaho, to Roseburg, Oregon; that the said article of food is misbranded within the purview of Title 21, United States Code, Section 343 (e)(2) in that the packages do not bear an accurate statement of quantity of the contents since the statement "Weight One Pound" is incorrect, that all persons claiming any right, title or interest in and to the said article of food are hereby notified to appear on or before the 24th day of January, 1949, in the Federal Court at Portland, Oregon, to show cause, if any there be, why the same should not be decreed against and forfeited to the United States as misbranded.
