# Malnutrition Victim Leaves \$100,000 Estate

MEDIA, Pa., Jan. 14 — (P) — Sarah Malin Caldwell, 81-year-old recluse whose death last Dec. 23 was attributed to malnutrition, left an estate valued at more than \$100,000. It was disclosed by her will filed for probate Wednesday in Delaware county court.

Miss Caldwell's body was found last month in her small home at Chester, Pa.—a house which police said was without electric lights and which was heated by a coal stove in the kitchen and an oil heater she carried from room to room.

Under the will, Miss Caldwell left her entire estate to a first cousin.

# Funeral Home Denies Ban On Burying Mexican GI

THREE RIVERS, Tex., Jan. 14 — (P) — The manager of the Rice Funeral Home here said he had not refused to handle the reburial service for a Latin-American soldier.

In fact, said T. W. Kennedy, "There was no question whatever of discrimination involved." Senator Johnson (D-Tex.) had arranged for Felix Longoria of Three Rivers to be buried in Arlington National Cemetery with full military honors. Johnson said he was informed the funeral home refused to handle the service "solely because of his Mexican ancestry."

Kennedy said:  
"The report that we refused to

handle the reburial of Latin-American soldier is incorrect. The first World War II soldier to be reburied at Three Rivers was a Latin-American. We handled the service."

# Rental Refund Demanded Under Alleged Agreement

Ralph Gurnes has filed suit in Circuit Court asking judgment for \$410 against E. P. Martin. Gurnes in his complaint states that this amount is due him as a rental refund, following "redemption" on a one-year lease agreement. The original rent paid by the plaintiff, says the complaint, was \$560, but after one month the two parties "agreed to a revision of the agreement, but allegedly no refund has been paid."
