

Blizzard-Trapped Flier Saved After Six-Day Ordeal

DENVER, Jan. 19.—(AP)—"I did a lot of praying and even made out my last will and testament but never gave up hope that I would be rescued."

Those were the words of William H. Harrison Jr., Granby, Colo., flyer who was picked off an 8,000-foot plateau yesterday after spending six days and nights in the mountainous wilds near the Colorado-Utah border.

He was rescued by a ski plane after a crash atop the mesa last Wednesday. Temperatures in the area had been as low as 40 below zero during that time.

The 39-year-old ex-army pilot was brought to Denver last night in a B-17 bomber and was taken to the Fort Logan Veterans Hospital where doctors are attempting to save his badly frozen feet.

Harrison had been the object of a widespread air search since he took off from Rock Springs, Wyo., for Grand Junction, Colo., Jim Eskridge, Colorado civil air patrol pilot, who sighted him from the air, and O. C. LeBoutillier, both of Craig, Colo., made the successful pickup and flew Harrison to a hospital.

Eskridge had dropped food and clothing to the stranded man after first spotting him but said later that Harrison told him he

could not eat the food because it was frozen.

Grinning through a six-day growth of whiskers, Harrison last night told how his plane was caught in a fierce mountain blizzard. When he attempted to climb over it, his engine began failing. "Before I knew what was happening I was in a spin, and was almost touching a mountain. I picked out the softest snowbank I could see and pancaked her," he said. "The plane wasn't damaged a bit."

California's Loss May Prove Florida's Gain

ORLANDO, Fla., Jan. 20.—(AP)

Citrus growers were advised by a Florida Citrus Commission official here this week to hold their oranges for higher prices ahead. "If we can control shipments during the next few weeks, there is no reason why prices cannot be stabilized at profitable levels," said Marvin H. Walker, commission general manager.

He said Florida oranges are in a "favorable supply and demand situation" because of the California freeze and a possible shortage of fruit for canning and concentrating.

The net effect of the cold weather on the Pacific Coast, he said, will be to reduce the volume of California orange shipments by 250 to 300 cars a week for the next three months.

Ex-Convict Held As Slayer of Prosecutor

EL PASO, Tex., Jan. 19.—(AP)—

Roy Frank Godby, ex-convict wanted for the slaying of Earl Pruet, Oklahoma city attorney, on Jan. 11, was picked up here today by city police.

Police Lieut. H. S. Bernhardt

said Godby denied shooting Pruet.

Godby had been sought since Jan. 13, two days after Pruet was shot to death in his Oklahoma City office. Pruet prosecuted Godby in 1932 for armed robbery as county attorney at Jefferson, Okla.

His killing was described as "one of vengeance." Godby was charged with Pruet's slaying after witnesses to the shooting identified him through photographs.

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Gambling Raiders Fined by Court

MOLINE, Ill., Jan. 19.—(AP)—

A mother and daughter whose attempts to halt slot machine gambling in Rock Island County were termed "insincere" were fined \$400 and costs as a result of their "raid" of a club here last Dec. 20.

"I doubt your sincerity in your gambling crusade," Magistrate Ralph Stephenson told Mrs. Elaine Van Meulebroeck and her daughter, Marie, 26, yesterday in finding them guilty of trespassing and disturbing the peace. The charges were in connection with the raid on the East End Bolders Club. Stephenson, in levying the fines, said the Van Meulebroecks "deliberately, unlawfully and violently took the law into their own hands."

The mother and daughter last fall had caused the arrests and fining of several tavern owners on charges of harboring slot machines. They started their anti-gambling drive after they had failed to solicit funds from saloon keepers for a proposed shelter for homeless animals.

was a girl of 16 in England. Her floral designs, boy-and-girl scenes, and landscapes appear on thousands of dishes, vases, lamps and figurines.

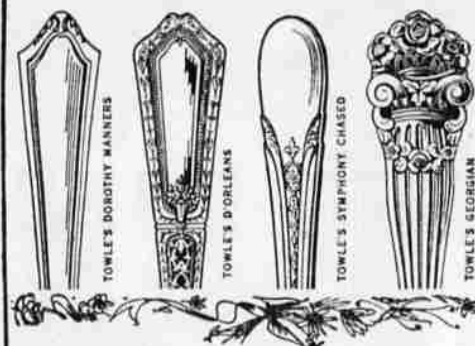
