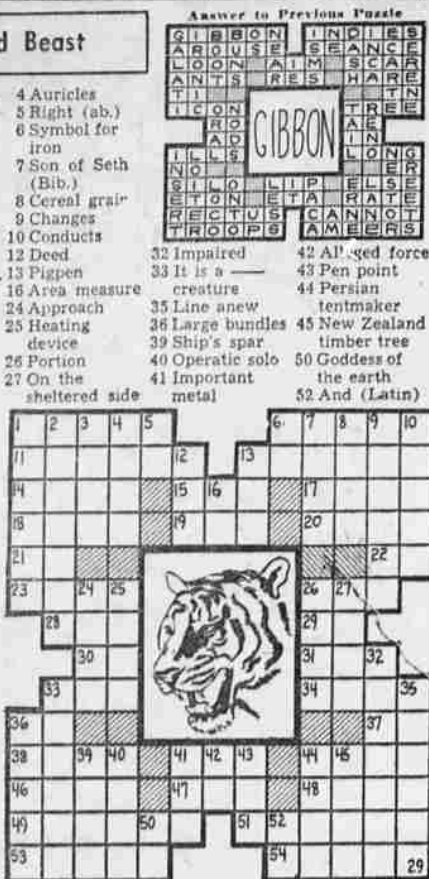

Basketball, Volleyball Tournaments Of B League Teams Scheduled For Determining County Championships

Plans for a tournament to select the B League Douglas County winners in volleyball and basketball were made at a meeting of coaches and principals at the Umpqua Hotel, Roseburg, this week.

The South Douglas tournament will be held at Riddle Feb. 9 and 11. The volleyball games will start at 6:30 p. m., with Riddle meeting Glendale, followed by the Days Creek and Canyonville girls. The losers of these two games will meet at 6:30 p. m. Feb. 11, for the consolation tie and the winner will play for the district championship immediately afterward.

Following the volleyball games each night will be the basketball games. Riddle against Days Creek, and Glendale against Canyonville Feb. 9, with finals Feb. 11.

The North Douglas tournament will be held during the same week at Riddle, with Drain, Elkton, Yoncalla, Oakland and Glendale taking part. The first and second place winners at Drain and Riddle tournament will meet in the Riddle Gym on Feb. 16 and 18 to decide the county winners.

Oregon Waterfowl Fed To Avert Starvation

PORTLAND, Jan. 28.—(AP)—Wildlife agencies and Oregon sportsmen are saving thousands of waterfowl from starvation in the cold spell.

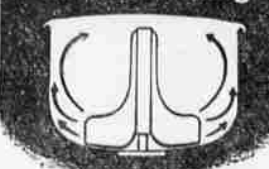
They are spreading grain in the frozen and snow-covered areas, and where in the past hundreds of birds have died, few have fallen victim to the weather this winter.

Paul Quick, assistant regional director of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, estimated that in Western Oregon alone five tons of grain have been distributed in the past few days.

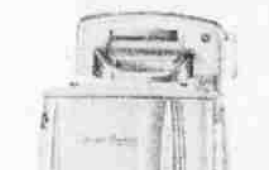
Sportsmen's groups have made long trips into natural feeding grounds—now frozen—in Eastern Oregon to save other thousands of birds.

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People of Pacific Northwest To Have Chance to Take Part In CVA Plans and Policies

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27.—(AP)—Rep. Mitchell (D-Wash.) said today the people of the Pacific Northwest "will have a full opportunity to participate in Columbia Valley Authority legislative plans and policies."

Mitchell said the basic legislation for the authority was drafted several years ago, when he sponsored such a bill in the Senate.

The main purpose in revising the legislation as requested by President Truman, he said, is to incorporate "beneficial changes suggested by recent experience."

Rep. Horan (D-Wash.) asked the White House to give people of the Northwest a voice in preparing the legislation and in governing the authority.

"I favor the maximum home rule in CVA compatible with the duties and responsibilities of the federal government in regional resource administration," Mitchell told a reporter.

"The legislation should provide that two members of the CVA board be selected from the region and also establish an effective advisory group which includes governors' representatives from the states in the Columbia basin."

Mitchell said opposition legislation is enacted, full hearings will be held.

Mitchell said opposition to the CVA plan by Gov. Arthur Langlie of Washington "is not very realistic."

"I hope he will not see fit to join forces with the high-paid private utility lobbyist, Purcell Smith, who has the effrontery to announce that the people of the Northwest have no need for a CVA," he said.
