LaBelle Duo Takes On Tonys In Tag-Team Battle Tonight

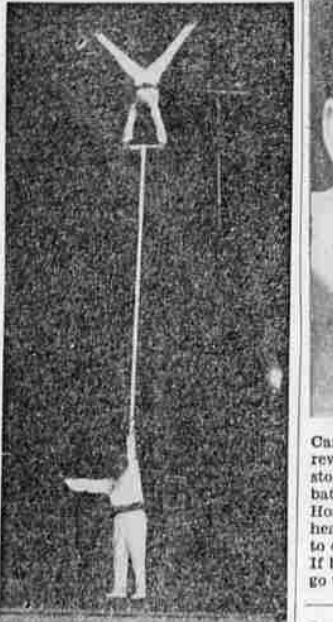
A tag-team match, pitting Pierre and Rene La Belle against Tony Ross and Tony Falletti tops the wrestling card tonight at the local Armory.

Censorship Order Of Defense Secretary Rapped

SEATTLE, May 28.—(AP)—A reformed Chicago industrialist sharply criticized here a recent government censorship directive which he termed a step toward dictatorship.

He referred, said Frank A. Hecht, president of the Navy League of the United States, to an order issued by National Defense Secretary Louis A. Johnson providing that all armed forces news or other releases must be subject to "review for security, policy and propriety."

Hecht stressed that the league is a civilian not a veterans' organization, and that he had never served in the Navy.

He also asserted former Navy Secretary John L. Sullivan did not resign primarily because of cancellation of construction of a new super-aircraft carrier, but over the basic issue of who is to run the Navy.

There is imminent danger that the Navy and other armed services will be run "by an autocratic civilian responsible only to the President and not to Congress and the people," he said.

LEBANON, Ore., May 28.—(AP)—Graduation exercises were held at Lebanon High School Thursday for Freddie, a little brindle dog of uncertain ancestry.

Principal Burlingh Cash, who presented a diploma to Freddie before a student assembly, said probably no regular student had attended as many classes in the past five years as Freddie.

When his master, Jody Blount—who who graduated next month—was unable to attend school for a day or two, Freddie went anyway. There was a seat for him in each classroom and he sat, or sometimes dozed, in it.

Medford Scores High In Invitational Meet

MEDFORD, May 28.—(AP)—Four record-breaking performances were turned in here last night as Portland defeated Southern Oregon High Schools in their annual track meet, 68 1/2 to 61 1/2.

The times in all four were better than the state records, although not eligible for consideration.

Mervin Brock, Washington High of Portland, had a hand in two. He won the 100-yard dash in 9.9 seconds. The state mark is 9.8.

He also was anchor man on the Washington relay team that won in 1:31.2 minutes the state mark is 1:31.3.

Jack Morris, Medford, tied the state mark of 14.9 in the high hurdles, then ran the lows in 22.6 seconds. The state mark is 22.3.

Rich Rings, Medford, did the 220-yard dash in 21.7 seconds. The state mark is 21.8.

Washington of Portland followed Medford in individual points with 20. Third was Grants Falls with 11.2. Klamath Falls, 13, was fourth; Jefferson, 11. Fifth, Miller of Roseburg placed third in the 100-yard dash behind Brock of Washington and Riggs of Medford.
