### Sketches Of Two Jr. High Students To Be Exhibited

SAN FRANCISCO, June 1.—Sketches by two Roseburg Junior High School students were selected this week for special exhibit in Washington, D. C., and other parts of the country prior to being shipped to foreign schools under the American Junior Red Cross international art project.

Chosen from among a group of more than 1,000 examples of art submitted by students in six western states and Alaska were the works of Ken Reson and Frances Cooper, both of Roseburg Junior High School.

The majority of the sketches submitted, together with those selected for the special exhibit, will be shipped abroad where they will become the property of schools in fourteen foreign countries participating in the project. Through the project a range of school art work depicting various phases of school and community life between the juniors and school children of many lands, the project seeks to promote international understanding and good will.

Judging was held Monday at the Pacific area headquarters of the Red Cross in San Francisco by a panel comprising Miss Ann Jones, professor of art at the University of Colorado, Miss Ida May Anderson, art supervisor of the Los Angeles city schools and Miss Lucille Durfee, art supervisor of Phoenix, Arizona. Selections for inclusion in the project were made primarily on the merits of the sketches' ability to reflect a true portrait of everyday life in an American community with technical quality a secondary consideration.

### Red Contempt At Slav Rites Branded Insult

BELGRADE, Yugoslavia, June 1.—(AP)—The official Communist party newspaper, Borba, complained bitterly Tuesday that the Russians insulted Yugoslavia, her national anthem and her premier, Marshal Tito.

The newspaper said Soviet representatives at Memorial services for a Red Army soldier at Lazarevo failed to salute when the Yugoslav anthem was played and sat down when the audience chanted praise of Tito, who has been denounced by the Communist parties outside Yugoslavia. Borba said this was a practice the Russians did not employ even against capitalist countries.
