**Boy Blind Since 3 Wins Highest University Award**  
RENO, Nev., June 7.—(AP)—The highest scholastic award of the University of Nevada went to a student totally blind since the age of three.  
Bonifacio Yturbe, 21-year-old major in political science, won the university's Herz gold medal with a straight "A" average in his four years of college. He received the award at commencement.  
Dean Frederick Wood of the Arts and Sciences College said it was the first perfect record in his 17 years at the university.  
When Yturbe was three years old he and his mother became violently ill after eating toadstools, mistaken for mushrooms. She recovered without lasting effects, but the boy has been blind since. Doctors said the poison apparently destroyed the optic nerves.  
Yturbe attended schools for the blind at Stockton, Calif., and Salem, Ore. After a year at the Oregon State School for the Blind, he attended public high school at Salem for a year and finished high school here.
