

Boy Blind Since 3 Wins Highest University Award

RENO, Nev., June 7.—(P)—The Blind, he attended public high highest scholastic award of the school at Salem for a year and University of Nevada went to a finished high school here, student totally blind since the age of three.

Bonifacio Yturbide, 21-year-old major in political science, won the university's Herz gold medal with a straight "A" average in his four years of college. He received the award at commencement.

Dean Frederick Wood of the Arts and Sciences College said it was the first perfect record in his it? years at the university.

When Yturbide was three years old he and his mother became violently ill after eating toadstools, mistaken for mushrooms. She recovered without lasting effects, but the boy has been blind since. Doctors said the poison apparently destroyed the optic nerves.
