Hawaii Strikers Offer To Unload Cargoes Of Food

HONOLULU, June 15.—(AP)—Conditional employer acceptance of a CIO stevedore offer to unload food and feed from strike-bound ships marked Hawaii's 45-day waterfront tieup Tuesday.

To a proposal made by the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union (ILWU) the Negotiating Committee of Waterfront Employers replied: "We accept your offer to unload all food and feed already declared essential by the governor's emergency food committee from all ships now in Hawaii harbors, provided you mean to unload the ships without 'ifs' and 'buts' involving non-stevedoring matters over which we have no control."

At the same time the employers rejected an ILWU proposal which would have permitted the Matson Line's luxury liner Lurline to sail from Honolulu. She has been tied up here since shortly after the strike began May 1.

The union had offered to let the Lurline return immediately to the West Coast and make another round trip as a tourist and food relief ship. Future sailings, the union said, should be a matter for arbitration.

The union struck for \$1.72 an hour, a boost of 32 cents. The employers offered 12. The union offered to unload food and feed from the strike-bound ships at the old rate of \$1.40 an hour.

Rep. F. D. Roosevelt Backs Truman Program

WASHINGTON, June 15.—(AP)—N. Y. received his oath of office Tuesday as a member of the House of Representatives.

The third son of the late President, to whom he has been compared in political charm, came here from New York to be sworn in by Speaker Rayburn (D-Tex.).

The 34-year-old attorney said he felt the major domestic issues confronting Congress were repeal of the Taft-Hartley law and enactment of a labor law "based on a free labor movement" enactment of President Truman's civil rights program, and a national housing program.

"I was elected on a program which is in accord with President Truman," Roosevelt said.

A new House roll call booklet issued Tuesday carries the name of Rep. Roosevelt (D-N.Y.) in italic type, the designation for Republican members.

"It's all a mistake," a member of the House clerk's staff said "We'll have to correct it."

Warden Quits One Priso For Higher Pay In 2nd

CHICAGO, June 15.—(AP)—John R. Cranor, 64, appointed warden of the Cook County (Chicago) jail only 35 days ago, resigned Tuesday.

Cranor informed Sheriff Elmer M. Walsh he was quitting the \$5,800 a year post to accept a better paying job as warden of the Washington State Penitentiary at Walla Walla. The Washington position pays \$1,000 more annually than he was receiving here.

Cranor, former penological specialist on Gen. Douglas MacArthur's staff in Tokyo was appointed head of the Cook County jail May 9 in a surprise move when Sheriff Walsh announced he had fired Frank G. Sain, warden for 14 years. Sain is now superintendent of Chicago's house of correction.

Extreme Fire Danger Closes Areas Of Washington Timber To Public

Several thousand acres of timber land have been closed to the public in Washington because of the extreme danger of forest fires.

State Forest Bernard Orell said in Olympia today several townships of tinder-dry country in the Mineral and Cat Creek areas of Eastern Lewis County have been closed.

Other closed areas are the South Olympic Tree Farm near Shelton, the Clemons Tree Farm in the Grays Harbor Area and the Vail Tree Farm east of Rainier.

Entry into closed areas is allowed only on a permit issued by a district fire warden, Orell said.

"Extreme caution is necessary if we are going to stay on top of the situation," Orell said.

All fires within state jurisdiction are under control, he added.

SPOKANE, June 15.—(AP)—The forest fire situation is the most dangerous in 30 years throughout the inland empire, A. B. Curtis, Orofino, chief fire warden for North Idaho Timber Protective Associations, says.

"Fire hazards today equal those normally encountered late in July or in August," Curtis said. "A swift snow runoff left soil unseasonably dry, Curtis said.

"We've had very little rain since May 1 with the result that forest areas are tinder dry. There is little green undergrowth and everything is in the making for a serious fire threat."

North Idaho already has had 14 forest fires this season, he said.

"Unless we get rains, we may face the situation we faced in 1910 when the Northwest experienced the most disastrous forest fires in history," he said.

Safeway Stores' Suit Tests Order On Liquor

PORTLAND, June 15.—(AP)—Safeway Stores, Inc. Monday filed suit to test an Oregon Liquor Control Commission order prohibiting the grocery chain from storing beer and wine in central warehouses for redistribution to its stores.

The suit in Circuit Court seeks to determine whether such storage violates the state liquor control act.
