Skin Grafting Restoring Burned Child To Health

PHILADELPHIA, July 22.—(AP) Little Melvin Hill "is over the worst" of a series of skin grafting operations to repair the damage caused by a blast of kerosene last December 9.

That was the good word today from the five-year-old boy's doctor, Hans May, who says of his patient: "He's one of the nicest little boys I've ever seen."

Melvin, one of 10 children of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Hill of Flemington, Pa., suffered third degree burns from his waist down as he poked a kerosene-covered shovel into a furnace.

He spent four months in a hospital before he was brought to a hospital in Philadelphia last April for a long series of skin grafting operations.

"He was just a ghost of a little boy when he came," Dr. May recalled.

More Heat Faced By South And East

CHICAGO, July 22.—(AP)—Another day of hot, humid weather appeared in prospect today for most of the southern and east-central states.

Some parts of the hot belt got a measure of relief from thunder showers, but temperatures in the high 80s and 90s were forecast.

Meanwhile, cooler air spread into the northern plains states while temperatures over most of the midwest were around normal. The mercury hit above 100 in parts of Kansas, Nebraska and Texas yesterday.

Light rain fell in the central plains and upper Mississippi valley today.

A severe rain-hail-electrical storm struck southern New England last night after yesterday's 90 plus temperatures. Seven persons died in the storm, including two struck by lightning and four drownings. Damage from fire and high winds was heavy while the expensive Connecticut valley tobacco crop suffered severe damage.
