Rep. Powell (D-NY) said Thursday 13 members—a majority of the House Labor committee—have agreed tentatively to a compromise aid to education bill.

Other committee members and termed Powell's announcement 'premature' but said the compromise has strong support. As proposed by Rep. Burke (Dolhio), it would limit the use of federal money to pay salaries of public school teachers.


