### Union Secretary Quits Reds With Indignation

CHICAGO, Aug. 16.—(AP)—Maurice Travis, secretary-treasurer of the CIO Mine, Mill and Smelters Workers union, Monday announced his resignation from the communist party "with a great sense of indignation."

Travis, a storm center in a stormy union, said that as a result of his resignation he has signed a Taft-Hartley non-communist affidavit, and that the union is now in full compliance with the law.

The resignation from the communist party membership "was not an easy step for me to take," Travis said. "I believe under our bill of rights, for which our forefathers fought, that an American has as much right to be a communist as he has to be a republican or a democrat, a Jew or a Catholic, or an Elk or a Mason."

### Crop Insurance Expansion Bill Sent To White House

WASHINGTON, Aug. 16.—(AP)—Legislation calling for a 50 percent expansion of the government's experimental crop insurance program was passed by the House Monday and sent to the White House.

The original crop insurance program was cut back to experimental size a few years ago when a \$73,000,000 deficit was accumulated in the old program. Under the legislation finally passed Monday the \$73,000,000 deficit would be wiped out by the federal treasury making up the loss.

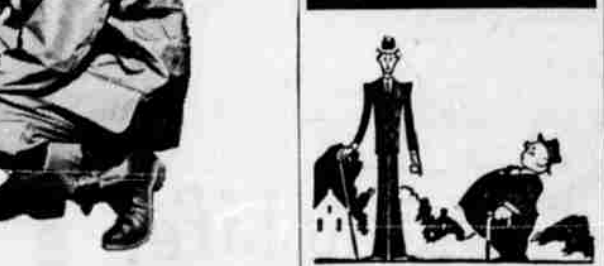

### Roseburg Gets \$10,452 Gasoline, Motor Revenue

In the first mid-year distribution of state gasoline tax and motor vehicle revenue to Oregon cities, Roseburg received \$10,452 today, Secretary of State Earl Newberry announced at Salem.

The distribution is being made under a new state law calling for semi-annual instead of annual payments. The twice-yearly payment, comprising 10 per cent of the total revenue, permits cities to undertake projects without having to borrow funds.

**Defense Setup Must Share  
In Budget Cut, U. S. Told**

SEATTLE, Aug. 16.—(AP)—The United States cannot sustain a \$45,000,000 budget indefinitely, and the national defense establishment will have to absorb its share of the cuts, Navy Secretary Francis Matthews said here Monday.

Matthews, here for an inspection tour of 13th Naval district installations, pointed out the army, navy and air force appropriations represent one-third of the total national budget.
