

U. S. Agencies Get Delayed Money

 The two were married May 27 in the town hall at Vallauris, near Cannes.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 18.—(AP)—Swift action on Capitol hill pulled a number of big government agencies out of a financial hole today.
 But nearly \$30,000,000 in operating funds that should have been voted six weeks ago still were snarled up in Congress.
 Sept. 15 is the new deadline for solving the tangle—the third new deadline Congress has set since June 30.
 Quick teamwork between chairmen Cannon (D-Mo) and McKellar (D-Tenn) of the House and Senate appropriations committees ended a temporary financial emergency late yesterday for a long list of government agencies which have been waiting for passage of their regular appropriations since the new fiscal year started July 1.
 Cannon and McKellar sped approval of a stop-gap measure so about 40 government agencies can continue meeting payrolls and other expenses.
 The emergency money bill went to the White House last night for President Truman's signature.
