Capital Accounts In Oregon Banks Increased

PORTLAND, Aug. 25. (AP) — National and state banks in Oregon have increased capital accounts in the past year, a State Bank Superintendent A. A. Rodgers said today. Capital rose from \$76,453,098 to \$82,320,300, an increase of \$5,867,202. The national banks set capital at \$71,030,086; state banks and trust companies, \$11,290,212. Deposits declined from \$1,263,236,355 a year ago to \$1,291,164,421. Total assets were down from \$1,447,839,915 to \$1,381,524,007.

Kerr-Anaconda Power Line Plan Gets Senate O. K.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 25. (AP) — The Senate approved Wednesday construction of the Kerr-Anaconda power line of the Bonneville Power administration in Montana. By a vote of 5 to 35 it wrote language into the Interior Department appropriation bill to authorize use of money to build the line. The amendment was proposed by Senator Magnuson (D-Wash.) The Senate Appropriations committee had recommended against the project. Its construction was approved by the House in passing the Interior bill. It was the third setback for the committee in the last two days. Twice Tuesday during consideration of the half-billion dollar Interior Department Appropriation bill a group of senators beat down amendments to restrict power line financing.
