### Reed Professor Reports Soviet Side Pretty Bad

PORTLAND—(AP)—A Reed college political science professor, back from a visit on both sides of Europe's "Iron Curtain," finds things pretty good on the western side and pretty bad on the Soviet side.

Dr. Frank Munk, who led a Columbia university study tour sponsored jointly by Reed college, said that in his native country of Czechoslovakia he found Prague "drab and gray, people ill clad, everybody unhappy and afraid to talk. Only three years ago they were hopeful and production was getting up. I couldn't have believed it if I hadn't seen it with my own eyes."

But there is disunity and in Czechoslovakia 30 percent of the people are "radishes—Red outside and white inside."

In western Europe, Dr. Munk found the peak danger of Communism passed but "the great trial will come in 1952 when the Marshall plan is supposed to end."

Future stability of Europe depends in great part, he said, on both United States' direct efforts and on "such things as the Voice of America" broadcasts—"everybody listens to it back of the Iron Curtain. It is a great force for good in Europe today."

### Three Men Are Killed In Cavern Of Tunnel

HELENA, Mont., Sept. 15. — (AP)—Three men were killed and one injured when 25 tons of rock and concrete crashed in a railroad tunnel under the Continental divide west of here yesterday.

These members of a jackhammer crew were hurt fatally: Marvin A. Hagen, 28, East Helena; Orville E. McCullum, 46, Mullan, Idaho; Roy J. Belveal, 48, Goodrich, Col.

Foreman Dean E. Bailey of Helena was injured but is recovering in a hospital here. Seventeen men escaped injury.

The cavern occurred about 11 a. m. in the Northern Pacific's Mullan tunnel, 13 miles west of Helena.

An 18-foot wall fell without warning on men working 385 feet beneath the Continental divide, about 1,000 feet in from the east portal of the 3,800-foot tunnel on the NP's main line for freight.
