Before they left here for Reno, attorney W. C. McCluskey, who had represented both women at the court, asked who their husbands had fallen in love with. "Her," said Mrs. Godard, pointing to Mrs. Hayes, who was pointing at Mrs. Godard.

Commerce Chief Expects Upward Economy Swing

PORTLAND, Sept. 22.—(P)—Secretary of Commerce Charles Sawyer told directors of the Chamber of Commerce last night that he expected the economy to perk up and improve in the months ahead. This was based, he said, on the assumption there would be no prolonged strikes in basic industry.

He said there were some soft spots in textile and metal working industries of New England and in scattered points of the South and Mid-West. On the West coast, he said, the continued high production of fruits and vegetables was giving some trouble to both growers and packers.

Commenting on the British devaluation of the pound, Sawyer said "I am inclined to think there has been an over estimate of the effect on our situation. There will probably be less price changes than have been anticipated in some quarters."
