Spring Chinook Salmon Will Be Hatched By Rock Creek **Operations For First Time**

For the first time in its history the game commission hatchery on Rock creek will hatch spring chinook salmon. James Vaughn, superintendent, is trapping a few salmon from the Umpqua river. Approximately 23,000 eggs have been received from the Imnaha river, and it is hoped that about 50,000 additional eggs will be forthcoming from various sources.

The hatchery also is preparing to handle about 500,000 fall chinook eggs promised by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife service in exchange for rainbow trout eggs already delivered by the Oregon largest poisoning operation, every commission.
