Spring Chinook Salmon Will Be Hatched By Rock Creek Operations For First Time

For the first time in its history the game commission hatchery on Rock creek will hatch spring chinook salmon. James Vaughn, superintendent, is trapping a few salmon from the Umpqua river. Approximately 23,000 eggs have been received from the Innaha river, and it is hoped that about 50,000 additional eggs will be forthcoming from various sources.

The hatchery also is preparing to handle about 500,000 fall chinook eggs promised by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife service in exchange for rainbow trout eggs already delivered by the Oregon commission.

Ross Newcomb, resident biologist, reports that 10,000 silverside salmon, hatched at Bandon and now of legal size, will be released in the Umpqua river. They will be tagged by fin clipping. They will be returned as to the percentage of return.

Cuban Claims New Mark In Gibraltar Swim

TARIFA, Spain, Sept. 22. — (AP) — Eduardo Cortinas of Cuba swam the Straits of Gibraltar from Spain to Morocco yesterday. Spanish naval authorities said he had beaten by five minutes the record for a single crossing.

There was no indication whether the Cuban will make it a round-trip, as originally planned.

The record is unofficial until the naval tug which accompanied him with official timers aboard returns to Spain.

Tuesday night after spending several days in trash fish poisoning activities. He added in poisoning Big Lava lake, near Bend, the largest poisoning operation ever conducted. The entire lake was treated apparently with complete success, Newcomb said. Trash fish had so exhausted the lake that searchers could discover only three game fish in the destroyed population. The lake will be permitted to rest until the poison disappears, then will be restocked with freshwater shrimp preparatory to being planted with trout.

Game department employees poisoned 10 miles of Row river Tuesday, Newcomb reports. The poison was spread in the Dorena dam reservoir area where infestation with trash fish was heavy. Game fish will be planted in the reservoir. If they fail to thrive, it is planned later to stock the area with spiny ray species.

Pope Pius Urges Films To Stress Family Service

CASTEL GANDOLFO, Sept. 22. — (AP)—Pope Pius XII has called upon the cinema to devote itself to the service of family unit "rather than debase itself in intrigues of divorce and separation."

The Pontiff, addressing members of the International Family Union received in special audience yesterday, urged press and radio, as well as films, to cooperate in defending the family. His address was made public today.

Speaking in French, the Pontiff declared: "Of what aid could be the press, radio and cinema and how grave is their responsibility in regard to the family. "Should not the cinema, in effect, in place of debasing itself in intrigues of divorce and separation, place itself at the service of the unity of marriage, conjugal fidelity, the health of the family and the well-being of the hearth?"
