"Act Of God Baby" Of Theatrical Star Dies



NEW YORK, Sept. 24.—(AP)—Actress Mary MacArthur, 19, who became a celebrated figure in the theater world at birth as the "Act of God baby" of actress Helen Hayes, died Thursday.

The young woman's death came as she was preparing to appear next month in a supporting role with her mother in the Broadway premiere of a new play.

She died of what physicians termed a "generalized virus infection." Her father, newspaperman-playwright Charles MacArthur, and Miss Hayes were at her bedside.

The "Act of God baby" label was pinned to Miss MacArthur in a widely publicized theatrical controversy. It arose when her mother was forced to withdraw from a starring Broadway role in 1929 by the approaching birth of her child.

Her withdrawal resulted in closing of the play and a subsequent dispute over actors' salary rights.

Both Sides Rest In Trial Of Eleven Communists

NEW YORK, Sept. 23.—(AP)—The government and defense rested today in the conspiracy trial against 11 top members of the Communist party in the United States. The trial is in its 36th week.

Shortly before giving of evidence came to an end attorneys for both sides had conferred with Federal Judge Harold R. Medina regarding arrangements for arguments and summation.

Medina said he thought he had a plan "that will please everybody."

The judge excused the jury with instructions that its members should return for the wind-up on Oct. 4.
