

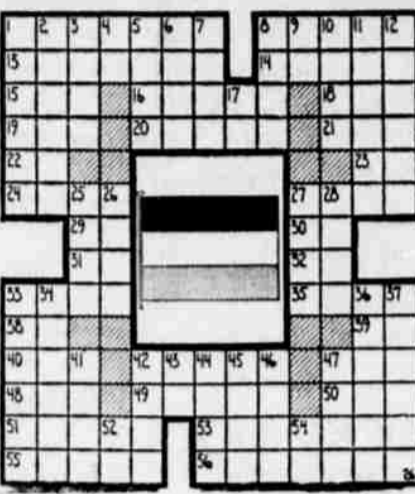

Lowell Thomas Badly Injured in Himalayas

NEW YORK, Sept. 24.—(AP)—Lowell Thomas, 57, author, news-caster and traveler, was seriously injured when thrown from a horse in the Himalayas, his office said Friday. The extent of his injuries could not be immediately learned but his office said the army airforce had been asked to rescue him from the tiny mountain village of Gyantse. Thomas recently left Tibet with a message from the Dalai Lama to President Truman. His son, Lowell Jr., was with him at the time of the mishap. The accident occurred in 17,000 feet high Karo pass as Thomas was returning to India on horseback from a visit to the Tibetan capital of Lhasa. Tibetan bearers carried him for six days to the village of Gyantse.

Senate Group OKs Truman's Point 4 Program

WASHINGTON, Sept. 23.—(AP)—The Senate Banking committee Thursday unanimously approved legislation designed to help carry out President Truman's "point four" program for economic improvement of underdeveloped areas of the world. The bill states "it is the policy of the United States, in the interest of its people as well as that of other people, to promote the development of economically underdeveloped areas of the world." To that end, the bill authorizes the export-import bank to "guarantee United States private capital invested in productive enterprises abroad which contribute to economic development in foreign countries, against risks peculiar to such investments." Senator Maybank (D-S.C.), the committee chairman, told reporters he does not expect final con-

gressional action on the measure at this session of congress. The project is called the point four program because it was the fourth point in a plan for peace and freedom outlined by Mr. Truman in his inaugural address last January.
