

Guinea Pig Trees Guide Students Of Forestry In Maine

 PRINCETON, Maine—There's a growth of trees in the Maine woods that is receiving meticulous attention.
 Everything noteworthy in the life of the trees is recorded—growth, effect of insects, and the hazards of lightning and wind included.
 The trees are in "sample woodlots" in Indian Township where 65 University of Maine forestry students have a 17,000-acre woodland laboratory. For 10 weeks each summer the students receive practical training in forestry and wildlife conservation.
 Just as a young medical intern works under the watchful eye of veterans of his profession, the students work in the woods with forest experts.
 The purpose of the training, says Prof. Arthur Randall, director of the camp, is to enable the students "to take charge of an area of forest land and manage it for perpetual production of forest crops."
 All of the trees in the sample woodlots are numbered with bright orange-painted labels.
 Year after year the record is kept, studies are made and each year a new group of young foresters learns under actual conditions what happens or doesn't happen to a cross section of the trees of Maine.
 The 17,000-acre forest is on land held in trust for the Passamaquoddy Indian tribe.

Automobile Television Banned In 15 States

CHICAGO—(AP)—If you want to stay out of trouble, don't look at a television show while you drive your car.
 It shouldn't be necessary to pass this warning along to anybody who can count without using his fingers. But 15 states are taking no chances. They adopted laws this year that either (1) prohibit operation of a motor vehicle equipped with a TV set in view of the driver, or (2) forbid installation of a set in a place where a driver can see it.
 The American Public Works Association says the states with such laws are Colorado, Connecticut, Indiana, Illinois, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Washington and Wisconsin.

Eugene Ranked Seventh In Building For August

SEATTLE—(AP)—Eugene ranked seventh among all the cities of Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, and Utah in building work last month, the magazine Construction News Bulletin reported.
 The Oregon town issued \$663,250 worth of building permits in August. It was outnumbered only by Portland, Seattle, Spokane, Tacoma, Idaho Falls, and Blackfoot, Ida. Even Salt Lake City was lower.
 The magazine survey showed that the entire six state area issued about \$2,000,000 more of building permits in August than in July.
 In Oregon, Portland ranked first. Then came Eugene, followed by Coos Bay, with \$240,031; Grants Pass, \$180,292; Medford \$134,615; Corvallis, \$131,030; Bend, \$110,486; and Klamath Falls, \$107,323.

A Money-Saving Winner!
 Heat 3 tbsp. shortening and add 1/2 cup celery, 2 tbsp. green pepper, 2 tbsp. onion, all finely chopped, and 1 pound ground beef.
 Cook over medium heat for 15 minutes; stir occasionally. Combine 2 tbsp. flour, 1 1/2 tsp. salt and dash of pepper, and stir into mixture.
 Gradually stir in 1/2 cup water and cook until thickened. Cool. Mix a recipe for baking powder biscuits using 2 cups flour. Roll out a 10"x12" rectangle on a lightly floured surface and spread with meat mixture. Roll as for jelly roll, starting with the long side, seal edge. Bake on a baking sheet in a moderately hot (400 degree F.) oven about 25 minutes. Serve immediately with Brussels sprouts, spiced crab apples, and a medium white sauce to which chopped parsley has been added. Yield: 6 to 8 servings.
