

# Secretary Matthews Believes Navy Cuts Impair Security

WASHINGTON, Oct. 10. — (AP) — Secretary Matthews said Saturday the navy believes that cuts in naval spending ordered in the Pentagon would impair the nation's security.

He testified in a house armed services committee hearing where a storm already had been set off by a charge that "secret orders" from the defense department threatened to ditch the navy's air arm.

Matthews said the navy is bucking the cuts and Secretary of Defense Johnson has agreed to give it a hearing.

Chairman Vinson (D-Ga.) first reported the cut orders, and said the apportionment was decided by "defense leaders in the Pentagon and the other services . . . out of sympathy with the navy air arm."

Vinson said the \$356,000,000 reduction assigned to the navy, outside the cuts made by Congress, would cut navy and marine aviation "about in half."

Building up his complaint of unfairness in the Pentagon, Vinson said he has reliable authority for a report that the air force wants all large aircraft carriers and their air groups out of the navy.

"The navy would become a protective convoy to move troops and fight submarines," Vinson said.

He got verification of his figures from Rear Admiral Herbert G. Hopwood, the navy's budget officer, and Wilfred McNeil, controller of the defense department.

McNeil said he knows of no discrimination against any one service. It is all in line, he said, with plans Johnson announced months ago to try to bring about an \$800,000,000 saving in defense spending.

# Oregon's Tax Exempt Property To Be Surveyed

SALEM, Oct. 11. — (AP) — The State Tax commissioner is going to make a survey to find out how much property in Oregon is exempt from taxation.

The commission said today it doesn't know how much tax exempt property there is in the state, but it said the amount "is prodigious in the aggregate."

That means there's a lot of it. Exempt property now includes that owned by charitable, religious, scientific and educational institutions.

The survey probably will be used by the next legislature to help decide what exempt property can be put back on the tax rolls.
