Kiwanis Buying Rubbish Cans For Business Sector

One rubbish can has already appeared on the streets of Roseburg, and indications are that at least nine more will be secured in the very near future.

A check for \$80 for four cans made out to the city by the Kiwanis club had to be returned, inasmuch as the city cannot accept or expend unbudgeted items, according to City Manager M. W. Stankard.

However, the Kiwanis will be given the privilege of paying for four cans, which have been ordered, upon their arrival. The city has granted permission for them to be installed upon the streets.

"The one can now up was purchased by the Lions club, and another has been ordered by the city. The Lions have ordered four more, which will arrive shortly.

About 30 cans in all will be needed to cover the entire city business district, according to Stankard. The possibility has been advanced that other service clubs may see fit to purchase the remaining cans, or a part of them. The city has no funds budgeted for such purposes this year.

A drive will be made to get the merchants to sweep their sidewalks and place the trash in the cans, instead of sweeping it into the streets. The city street cleaning trucks will empty the cans.

Washington Tops Oregon In Sales Of Timber

PORTLAND, Oct. 13.—(AP)—Timber sales and cut in the 19 national forests of Washington and Oregon dropped sharply during the third quarter of this year compared with the same period in 1948.

The U. S. forest service reported yesterday that sales were down to 302,805,000 board feet, less than half the 615,953,000 a year ago. Value was \$2,254,063, down from \$8,558,610.

The timber cut slid from 600,377,000 feet to 452,492,000 for the months of July, August and September.
