
Plane Crash Kills Two Officers; WAVE Saved DALTON, Ga., Oct. 21-(.P)-

DALTON, Ga., Oct. 21—(P)-Attempting an emergency land-ing on a hastily-lighted football field, a small Navy plane crash-ed into a cemetery Wednesday might, exploded and burned. Two reserve officers were killed and a Wave was seriously injured. Volunteers snatched the Wave from the flaming wreckage while firemen tried to extinguish the blaze.

blaze. The Wave, identified as Mary Goldstein of Gien View, III., was reported in critical condition at a hospital. The Atlanta Naval Air station listed the dead as Ensign Raiph Meeks Jr., the pilot, and Commander C. Ross Klester, both of Atlanta. They were re-servists. servists

Yugoslavia Wins Seat On **U. N. Security Council**

NEW YORK, Oct. 21. - (7) NEW YORK. Oct. 21. -6P – Yugoslavia won a seat in the United Nations Security council Thursday over the Soviet-spon-sored Czechoslovakia. The action by the 59-nation general assembly was a rebuff to the Cominform Soviet bloc. The vote on the second ballot was Yugoslavia 39 and Czecho-slovakia 19. Thirty-nine votes were required for election. Yugo-slavia thus squeezed by one the minimum number of votes needed. The voting was by secret

ballot. The United States supported Yugoslavia for the council seat now held by the Soviet Ukraine. The seating changes Dec. 31.

He in-cluded in this total the direct ap-propriations, the indefinite funds such as interest on the debt, and contract authority. Congress voted less in direct ap-propriations than the President requested, but it ignored his tax-increase recommendations. The
