Summer Home Owner Must Pay For Manhandling

SALEM, Oct. 26.—(AP)—A Portland man who went on a picnic and was beaten about the face with a rifle butt won \$4,537 damages Tuesday in a state supreme court decision.

The man, Edgar J. Scheuffle, was beaten by Leonard C. Newman, because Newman thought Scheuffle was fishing on the property of Newman's summer home,

located at the junction of Gordon and Sandy creeks 17 miles from Portland. The high court, in a decision by Justice Harry H. Belt, didn't decide whether Scheuffle was trespassing. But it said that doesn't make any difference, because no one has a right to beat anyone up like Newman did, trespassing or not.

Scheuffle took his wife and a few friends and relatives on a picnic July 4, 1946, to a recreation area near Newman's summer place. Scheuffle went fishing in the stream, and Newman told him to beat it, threatening him with a rifle.

Newman fired a shot to scare Scheuffle, and then beat Scheuffle up with the rifle butt. Scheuffle said he suffered a cut lip, cut jaw, fractured tooth, and injured nerves and tissue on his chin.

Newman admitted he injured Scheuffle, but said not to the extent of \$4,537. Justice Belt said in his opinion that Newman was "trigger-happy, and had a warped idea of what he could do in defense of his alleged property rights."
