## Record Gives "Service" At Funeral Of Atheist

DENVER—(AP)—The mourners faced the flower-covered coffin holding the last mortal remains of Oscar O. Whitenack, 79, former editor of the Denver Post open forum.

With some surprise, they noted the absence of clergy or music.

Then a voice spoke out: "This is my funeral. The clergy is a racket. I want no religious songs. This is going to be a perfectly rational funeral."

The voice was Whitenack's. Several months ago, expecting death which finally came Satur-

day, he had planned and recorded his own services.

The voice explained, "I am an atheist and have been for many years."

It went on to attack religion, the Bible, beliefs in a God.

There was a pause, then, very quietly, "That's all."

The body was buried in Crown Hill cemetery. The record was placed in the casket.

## Cardinal Marmaggi Dies, Reducing College To 54

ROME, Nov. 4.—(AP)—Francesco Cardinal Marmaggi, one of the top administrators in the Vatican, died Thursday following a heart attack. He was 73.

Cardinal Marmaggi, elevated to the sacred college in 1935, was prefect of the congregation of the council. He directed the application and enforcement of decrees of the Council of Trent and other church laws.

His death reduces the membership of the college of Cardinals to 54. The full membership is 70.

## Presidential Candidate Refuses To Discard Gun

MANILA, Nov. 4.—(AP)—Presidential Candidate Jose P. Laurel today balked at turning over personal firearms carried by his bodyguards during the last week of the feverish National Election campaign.

President Quirino banned the carrying of weapons except by police from Nov. 1 to Nov. 20. Laurel said he had been granted a permit to carry a weapon "for my protection." He refused to give it up. It is a submachine gun.

**TYPHOON KILLS 200**  
MANILA, Nov. 3.—(AP)—The Manila Chronicle tonight reported 200 persons were killed or drowned at Kabankalan, Negros Island, in the Philippines worst typhoon in years on Oct. 31. Additional storm damage was reported from the islands of Cebu, Leyte and Mindanao.

## First Methodist Pastor To Offer Unusual Series

A series of unusual evening worship services was announced today by the Rev. W. A. MacArthur, pastor of the First Methodist church. Each Sunday evening for the next eight months the local Methodist church will be cooperating with a nationwide program of "Advance for Christ and His Church."

The initial step in this four-year program is the building of a strong faith in the lives of Methodists, he said. A challenging outline has been presented to the ministry, which calls for preaching and teaching on eight different phases of faith. The month of November will be devoted to developing a greater faith in God. December will be building a faith in Jesus Christ, and on through the several months to come, faith in the Bible, love, prayer, immortality, the Holy Spirit, and the Kingdom of God.

The Rev. Mr. MacArthur will be preaching each Sunday morning on these themes, but special emphasis is to be given to congregational participation in the evening services. Pocket-size booklets have been prepared for the membership to read and use as a basis of discussion. The plan calls for an evening of sacred music, both vocal and instrumental, followed by a brief address by the pastor, and concluding with a question and answer period in which the worshipper can ask for information and help in some particular problem of faith.

The first of these evening hours will be held this Sunday, Nov. 6, at 7:30 p. m. in the Methodist church sanctuary. The Rev. Mr. MacArthur will illustrate his remarks with chalk drawings. As illustrative of the faith men have had in God and Jesus Christ he has developed a series of short talks on the "Businessmen of the Bible." The first of this series to be delivered this Sunday will be "The Man Who Made a Corner in Real Estate."

The public is invited to attend.

Weniger, pastor of Oakland's 23rd Ave. Baptist church, was named at a 10-state regional conference.

Dr. L. J. Julianel, pastor of the First Baptist church, San Francisco, and Dr. Earl S. Kalland, president of Western Baptist Theological seminary, Portland, were elected regional representatives to the national organization.

Dr. J. Palmer Muntz, Buffalo, N. Y., president of the national association, addressed the 1,000 delegates.
