Robinson Of Dodgers Tops "Value" Vote

Battina. Base-Stealing Champion Of National League Edges Musial

NEW YORK, Nov. 18 (AP)—J. Kie Robinson of the Brooklyn Dodgers, batting champion and second base spark of a pennant winner, has been elected most valuable player of 1949 in the National League.

First member of the Negro race to play in modern big league ball, the 30-year-old former UCLA collegian from Cairo, Ga., drew a total of 264 points to 226 for Stan Musial of the St. Louis Cardinals. Robinson said he was "very happy" over his selection.

Twenty four members of the Baseball Writers' association, three from each city in the circuit, acted as a committee. Each listed 10 players in order of their value and 12 of the 24 put Robinson on top.

Musial, who almost caught Robinson in the final stages of the batting race, drew five firsts. Enos Slaughter of the Cards and two of Robinson's Brooklyn teammates, Peeewe Reese and Carl Furillo, each received two first place ballots. The other one went to Lefty Kapheim of the Phillies' 17-game winning pitcher. Only Robinson and Musial were on every ballot.

Robinson, whose signing by Branch Rickey in the winter of 1945-46 surprised the baseball world, completed his third year in the big league by topping the hitters with a .342 average.

In addition to winning the batting crown, Robinson led the base stealers with 36. Included in his 203 hits were 38 doubles, 12 triples and 16 home runs. He drove in 124 runs, barely losing the division lead to Kiner when the Pirate slugger staged his home run rampage in the final month.

It was Robinson's take-a-chance swing on the base paths, his extra base hits and his fine fielding that helped Brooklyn in its second flag in three years.
