**East Germans Renew Battle Of Propaganda**

BERLIN—(AP)—East German communists have stepped up their propaganda campaign to get the Western powers out of divided Berlin by wooing Berliners to communism.

Franz Dahlem, eastern sector Communist party leader, told members at a party congress that the anti-communist situation in West Berlin is "unbearable."

"This bridgehead of Western powers must be rolled up from within," he said in a speech. "This position must be torn out of the hands of Germany's enemies. This is the central task the party now faces and for which it must concentrate all its forces."

Dahlem was reported in some quarters to have brought his orders for the new offensive directly from the recent Communist conference in Hungary.

The keynote of the propaganda was emphasized in all Soviet sector newspapers.

Dahlem proposed a number of "new fighting methods." He urged German prisoners of war who had returned from Russia to "join in the task" of combating western influence—an influence which in free elections twice has repudiated communism in west

**Bridges Active In Red Councils, Witness Asserts**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 6.—(AP)—Big, burly Henry Schrimpf said yesterday he had had many hot words with Harry Bridges but he denied having a "great hatred" for him.

Schrimpf, a native of Australia but now a United States citizen and a longshore walking boss, was under cross examination at Bridges' perjury and conspiracy trial.

"As long ago as 1937 did you not harbor a great hatred against Harry Bridges?" asked James MacInnis of defense counsel.

"I never expressed myself that way," Schrimpf retorted. "I fought him on many occasions on policy. Sometimes we came to very bitter words."

Bridges, president of the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's union, and two of his aides, Henry Schmidt and J. R. Robertson, are on trial—Bridges for perjury and conspiracy only, the others for conspiracy only.

**American Ships To Run Blockade To Red Shanghai**

HONG KONG—(AP)—Agents for the American-owned Isbrandtsen Company, Inc., say the line would put all of its ships on the lucrative blockade run to Communist Shanghai.

The United States and Great Britain do not recognize the Chinese Nationalist blockade.

(The American bureau of shipping lists seven ships owned by the Isbrandtsen Co., Inc., of New York, and 10 U. S. vessels operated by the firm.)

Other foreign ships have not penetrated the blockade.

Five Isbrandtsen ships have gotten through. Two of them were fired on by Chinese Nationalist warships. The last one, Hans Isbrandtsen claimed in New York, was on the high seas at the time. The two that were fired upon are the Flying Cloud

and Sir John Franklin. The latter is due to leave Shanghai shortly for Japan.

Isbrandtsen called for U. S. naval protection of his China trading ships. The demand was refused.

Last Thursday Isbrandtsen said Secretary of State Dean Acheson was "vehemently" waiting for the loss of American lives in the blockade.

Thousands of tons of cargo are being consigned to Isbrandtsen ships here in Hong Kong by shippers who have tried other lines.
