Doctors To Learn Of Atomic Hurts

WASHINGTON, (AP)—The government will start this spring to prepare doctors across the nation to treat atomic-war injuring a mong civilians.

The Atomic Energy commission announced that a series of one-week courses will be held for selected members of the medical profession, who in turn will instruct physicians, dentists and nurses in local areas.

The agency said it had prepared the program with the help of the National Security Resources board, which is the government's chief civil defense planning group and the General Services Administration, which has the task of blueprinting wartime disaster relief.

The courses will start in March at the Argonne national laboratory, Chicago; University of Rochester, N. Y., and Western Reserve university school of Medicine, Cleveland.

Later in the spring, courses will be offered at the University of California at Los Angeles; the University of Utah school of Medicine, Birmingham, and Johns university of Alabama school of Medicine, Birmingham, and Hahn Hopkins school of Medicine, Baltimore.
